

# Announcement of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Student Wiki Competition

## Submission Deadline – May 15, 2011

Greetings from the Society of Sensory Professionals (SSP) Wiki Committee!

We wanted to inform you that the **2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Student Wiki Competition** is well underway and we are actively seeking submissions from students.

The competition will reward the best Sensory Wiki submissions from students in sensory science or related fields. The top three submissions will be awarded with cash prizes of **\$750, \$500 and \$250**, respectively. Also, all student submissions that are accepted for posting on the Wiki will receive a **'FREE'** 2011 student membership to the Society of Sensory Professionals.

### Rules

- Must be a current student pursuing a degree at a University anywhere in the World. (*You do not have to be a student member of the Society of Sensory Professionals to participate.*)
- Submissions should be in English and at most 600 words
- Entries should follow the standard formatting of Wiki articles

- Subject matter for the article should be related to sensory or consumer science and the subject of the article cannot already be posted on the Sensory Wiki.

### Judging

Judging of the articles will be done by the editorial board of the Sensory Wiki. Results will be shared with Editorial Board on June 10<sup>th</sup> and winners announced on June 15<sup>th</sup> 2011. Articles will be judged for their (1) appropriateness for the sensory Wiki (2) completeness in describing the subject (3) adherence to the rules including formatting and (4) grammar.

The deadline for submissions will be **May 15<sup>th</sup> 2011** and winners will be announced on **June 15<sup>th</sup> 2011**.

The Sensory Science Wiki is a powerful on-line tool that creates a unique point of difference from other professional organizations. It is also an ideal platform for sharing knowledge, exchanging ideas and educating others in the sensory community.
